



## Mentors

MIHOA will have two types of mentor programs, on ice and off ice. Retired and active officials are eligible to be Mentors.

- **On Ice Mentors**

1. On ice mentors will physically be on the ice skating with the officials
2. Mentors will not act as an official in the game
3. Mentors will NOT have authority to overturn a call by the officials officiating the game.
4. Mentors are there strictly for coaching and offering performance improvement.
5. Mentors will be required to complete the Mentor Evaluation form in order to receive compensation

- **Off Ice Mentors**

1. Off ice mentors will NOT physically be on the ice skating with the officials
2. Off ice mentors will be positioned in the penalty box/scorekeepers area so they have access to the officials
3. Mentors will not act as an official in the game
4. Mentors will NOT have authority to overturn a call by the officials officiating the game.
5. Mentors are there strictly for coaching and offering performance improvement.
6. Mentors will be required to complete the Mentor Evaluation form in order to receive compensation

### Mentor Eligibility Requirements:

MIHOA Mentors need to have the necessary experience to properly mentor an official. The minimum requirements and experience for a Mentor are:

- **On Ice Mentors**

1. Must be a fully USA Hockey registered official
2. Must complete Safe Sport
3. Must complete background screening
4. Minimum 3 years experience
5. Assigned mentor has significant experience officiating at the skill level of the game, IE: Squirts, Midgets, AAA, Youth, High School, etc.)

- **Off Ice Mentors**

1. Must complete Safe Sport
2. Must complete background screening
3. Minimum 3 years experience
4. Assigned mentor has significant experience officiating at the skill level of the game, IE: Squirts, Midgets, AAA, Youth, High School, etc.)



# MIHOA Mentor/Supervisor Program Guidelines

## Compensation

The following Mentor games fees will be paid by MIHOA:

- **On Ice Mentors**
  1. \$35.00 per game fee for 60 minute game time
  2. \$5.00 Each additional 15 minutes of game time
  
- **Off Ice Mentors**
  1. \$30.00 per game fee for 60 minute game time
  2. \$2.50 Each additional 15 minutes of game time

Mentors will be required to complete the Mentor Evaluation Results form to receive compensation.

## Retired Officials Completion Bonus and Other Fees

The Missouri Hockey Affiliate will also reimburse retired officials for the USA Hockey registration, background screening fees and pay a completion bonus for completing all registration steps. Retired officials who are qualified to receive reimbursement will request payment directly from the Missouri Hockey Affiliate. Reimbursement does not apply to active officials.

- **Mentor Completion Bonus - \$75.00**

Bonus payment to retired officials for completing the required steps for becoming a Mentor. The bonus is in addition to payment to other fees.
  
- **Mentor Other Fees**

Retired officials will be reimbursed for other fees as outlined below.

  - **On Ice Mentors**

USA Hockey will require retired on ice officials to meet the following requirements with fees being reimbursed by the Missouri Hockey Affiliate:

    1. Register as a full USA Hockey official
    2. Attend a seminar
    3. Pass SafeSport
    4. Pass Background check
  
  - **Off Ice Mentors**

USA Hockey will require retired on ice officials to meet the following requirements with fees being reimbursed by the Missouri Hockey Affiliate:

    1. Register as an USA Hockey volunteer which has no fee
    2. Pass SafeSport
    3. Pass Background check

## Game Supervisor

Retired and active officials are eligible to be Game Supervisors.

### Game Supervisor Eligibility Requirements:

MIHOA Game Supervisors must have the necessary experience to properly supervise a game. The minimum requirements and experience for a supervisor are:

- Must be USA Hockey registered official
- Must complete Safe Sport
- Must complete background screening
- Minimum 4 years experience
- Assigned mentor has significant experience officiating at the skill level of the game, IE: Squirts, Midgets, AAA, Youth, High School, etc.)

### Game Supervisor Duties

- Supervisors will be positioned in the penalty box/scorekeepers area so they access to the officials
- Supervisors will not act as an official in the game
- Supervisors will NOT have authority to overturn a call by the officials officiating the game
- Supervisors are there strictly for performance evaluation and improvement.

### Compensation

- Minimum \$30 per game
- Two-man system games – \$30 or 50% of officials fee, whichever is greater
- Three and four man system, games - \$30 or 50% of linesman official fee, whichever is greater

USA Hockey will require retired Supervisors to meet the below requirements with fees being reimbursed by the Missouri Hockey Affiliate. Reimbursement does not apply to active officials.

1. Register as an USA Hockey volunteer which has no fee
2. Pass SafeSport
3. Pass Background check

Supervisors will be required to complete the Supervisor Evaluation Results form in order to receive compensation.
